





- 1) Take your art kit box and cut off the lid. On the top and bottom of the box, on the long sides, use a pencil and a ruler to mark about an inch and a half in from both outside edges. Using a pencil, poke a hole in the marked places. These will be the holes for your dowels to go through.
- 2) Tie a rubber band around each end of the dowel and slide it down until it reaches the cardboard box, this will keep the dowels in place while you turn your crankie.
- 3) Tape or glue your three sheets of paper together on the short sides, making one long sheet of paper. The three "pages" will have the scenes of your story.
- 4) Draw out your story with colored pencils. You can draw one long landscape on the three sheets like in the Baldini engraving to make a continuous narrative! Get creative with your story telling. Outline with a marker or use colored pencils or markers to really make your continuous narrative come to life.
